CLASSROOM EXPECTATIONS

PUPILS

- Arrive promptly to lessons
- Bring the appropriate books and equipment
- Be courteous to teachers and each other
- Remain seated unless instructed otherwise
- Maintain smart appearance, in correct uniform at all times
- Observe health and safety rules, and take special care in workshops and laboratories
- Do not eat or drink. Chewing gum is forbidden
- Do not operate personal stereos during lessons
- Ensure that mobile phones are switched off
- Always record homework in homework planners
- Respect other people, their feelings, their belongings and their right to achieve

TEACHERS

- Arrive promptly to lessons
- Take a class register on SIMs every period. Periods one and four are the official attendance figures.
- Take appropriate action regarding pupils who arrive late to class
- Follow the Behaviour Policy in response to unacceptable behaviour.
- Capitalise on opportunities to reward positive behaviour and achievement
- Do not eat or drink during lessons or chew gum
- Do not allow pupils to leave the classroom without very good reason and ensure you write in their planners
- Do not allow pupils to leave your class early
- Dismiss your class from the door at the end of the lesson
- Supervise corridors outside classrooms during lesson changeover
