



Return to School September 2020 UPDATE: Pupil Checklist

<i>For each of the statements in the table below, tick if you understand what is required of you. There will be an opportunity to ask questions and address any queries during your induction session.</i>	√
I know that if I am struggling, anxious or worried that I can speak to my Form Tutor, Pastoral Support Officer, or any member of staff, for help and support	
I know that I must not attend school if I or a household member have Covid-19 symptoms (a new persistent cough / temperature / loss of taste or smell) or have tested positive for Covid-19	
I know that I must not attend school if I have been advised to self-isolate as a result of the Government's Track & Trace system	
I know that if I start to feel unwell and display Covid-19 symptoms (a new persistent cough / temperature / loss of taste or smell) I must let an adult know immediately	
I know that I should not arrive at school prior to 8.45 and that I should go straight to my first class on arrival	
I know that I must get dropped off and picked up outside the school grounds / car park	
I know that I should enter through the allocated entry point for my year	
I know what a 2 metre distance looks like	
I know that I need to respect my own and others' safety by maintaining a 2 metre distance from adults at all times, including on the way to and from school	
I know that I must observe physical distancing and wear a face covering when in local shops and on public transport	
I know that I must avoid crowding with other pupils, and must avoid any physical contact (hugging / touching / pushing) with other pupils	
I know that I must use hand sanitiser when I enter the school and then regularly throughout the day	
I know that I must sanitise my hands when I enter the toilet area and must wash my hands thoroughly with soap and water for 20 seconds after using the toilet	
I know that I must cough or sneeze into a tissue (or my sleeve if I don't have a tissue) then bin the tissue immediately and sanitise my hands	
I know that I must avoid touching my face with unwashed hands	
I know that I cannot share my food or take food from anyone	
I know that when moving around the school I must observe signs on walls / floors, follow the one-way system, stay 2 metres away from staff and avoid crowding or direct contact with other pupils	
I know that I must take care when entering and exiting classrooms /corridors / toilets, to ensure that a 2 metre distance from staff who may be passing is maintained	
I know that I cannot move classroom furniture	
I know that I must remain seated at my allocated desk when in class	
I know that I am responsible for my belongings which must be kept in my bag at all times, and that my bag must be kept on the floor at all times in classrooms.	
I know that I cannot share my belongings / resources with anyone	
I know that I must clear everything away myself and that I must not touch or use anything that is not mine, or that I don't have permission to touch or use	
I know that there will be additional instructions in practical classes to keep me safe	
I know that I must bring a water bottle to school with me and that I will not be able to refill it while in school.	
I know that deliberate or repeated failure to adhere to safety rules will result in me being sent home
