#### **Dear Parents**

We have reached the end of another term and I cannot praise our pupils enough for how they have coped with the lockdown and return to school. We do understand the difficulties this presented but have been so impressed with pupils' dedication to their online lessons and how smoothly they have returned to learning in school. Thanks to all of you who have supported them and enabled this to happen. A special thank you to all the staff for their commitment and dedication to our pupils. I think we are now due a well-earned break.

We return to school on Monday 19<sup>th</sup> April and it will be a 'week B'. During the holidays please continue to test your child using the LFD tests, twice weekly, which we have provided. This is of course voluntary. If your child has not collected their tests they are freely available at all local testing sites. If your child develops symptoms on Friday or Saturday of this week and have a positive PCR result please let us know on <a href="mailto:schoolclosure@olcc.lancs.sch.uk">schoolclosure@olcc.lancs.sch.uk</a> There is no need to contact us if the symptoms occur after that.

#### Start times

After Easter we are hoping to move towards the usual school day so are reintroducing form time. Year 9 start time will now be 8:45. Sixth formers will only have form time on Mondays and need to arrive by 8:45. Other days they arrive for their first lesson. The rest of the school's starting times remain unchanged.

### Uniform

Hopefully the weather will improve and next term school will be much warmer. Pupils are still required to wear a jumper and blazer. On PE days, pupils may wear the school badged hoodies or their jumper and blazer. We hope that with the easing of lockdown accessing new items of uniform will be easier.

#### **Year 11 and Sixth Form Assessment**

Separate letters for these year groups are being emailed out to try and give more information about the practicalities of the assessment. Students in these year groups will need to spend time preparing and revising during the holiday to maximize their grades, as they would do in any other year.

## **Parking in Lune Street**

We have received complaints from local residents and a local councilor to say that residents of Lune Street are unable to access residential parking they have paid for due to parking of parents. We have also had parents expressing concern about the speed of traffic on Lune Street after school. Please be careful and courteous when dropping off and picking up from school. The school has a staff car park on Lune Street, behind the sports hall, which can be used for very short periods of time for pick up and drop off.
