

Week 6 Update

Hello and welcome to our latest bulletin.

You will have seen in the news that Lancashire's Director of Public Health has announced that schools will not be opening more widely next Monday. An announcement will be made weekly based on local knowledge and science. The reason for the decision was that although the number of cases are reducing they have not reduced enough in this area. Also the R value nationally is below 1 but it is above 1 in parts of Lancashire.

I understand that this will be frustrating for parents and pupils as it is frustrating for us too. I have spoken to a number of staff who cannot wait to be back in school, with our young people. However, we have to remember this decision is made on what is safe for pupils and staff.

We will text home again next Monday to let you know the decision. Of course the wider opening is for Year 10 and Year 12. All key stage 3 pupils will remain working from home.

I have posted my first virtual assembly for Year 7 in the Assembly Team, I will add one weekly and will try to post some for other years too. I do miss the daily contact with pupils and hope they are coping with working from home.

I hope you and your families are well and I hope to see you as soon as we can do safely.
