Dear Parent / Carer,

As specified by Mr Coyle in his letter regarding grades, Year 11 have a two-week period of classroom based exams beginning Monday 17th May and ending on Friday 28th May (the last day before the half - term break). These exams are important in informing their final grades so they should still be working hard at home for the next five weeks.

The official leaving date for Year 11 is Monday 7th June. This is following May half - term.

They must all come in to school that morning for P2.
