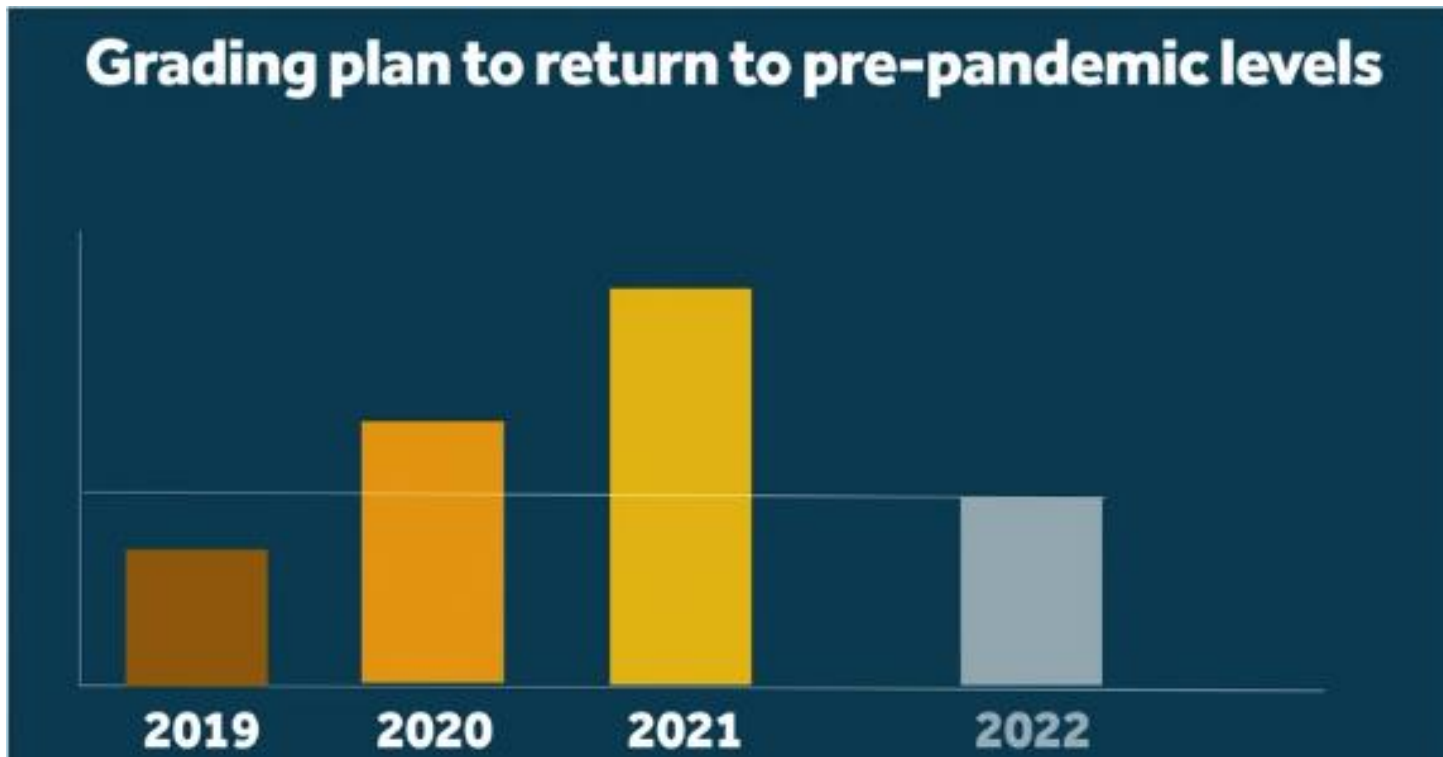

Preparing for the Real exams

- This year it's back to normal - anything can come up!
- Formulae sheets in maths, physics and combined science will continue
- Exams will not be spaced out as widely this year
- Individual exam timetables published in the new year
- Revision should be ongoing and include the holidays
- Internal assessment periods are in October, January and March
- Exam and revision timetable issued after Easter
- After school revision sessions will start after October HT
- Small group tutoring will start after October HT
- Revision packs will be given out including post it notes & revision cards

Teaching beyond the lesson

- Small group tutoring 8.00am to 8.30am voluntary
- Good morning English and maths during form time small groups compulsory
- After school revision sessions 3.05 to 4pm larger groups compulsory
- Small group tutoring 4.00pm to 5.00pm voluntary
