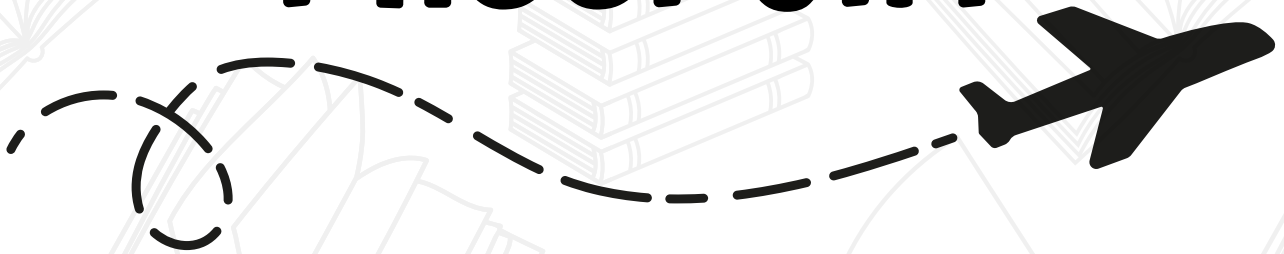

This Reading Passport is your guide to becoming a confident and adventurous reader.

Inside, you'll find the **Best Books Reading List** – a collection of exciting books from different genres, topics, and authors. Some books will make you think, some will teach you new things, and others will take you on amazing adventures.

Many of these books are available in the school library.

## Every time you finish a book from the list:

- Tick it off in your passport
- Ask a parent/carer to sign
- Ask an English teacher to sign

Reading regularly helps improve your vocabulary, imagination, and knowledge across all subjects – and it's a great habit to build in Year 7!

## Reading Rewards:

To celebrate your reading, you can earn rewards each term:

- **First Book:** Read your first book and earn a chocolate bar.
- **Three Books:** Read three books in a term and earn a Skip the Break/Lunch Queue pass you can use up to 3 times.
- **Six Books:** Read six books in a term and be invited to watch a film during school hours.

At the start of each term, the passport resets – so everyone gets a fresh chance to take part and earn rewards.

**When you have completed 1, 3 or 6 books, see Miss Wisdom for your prize!**





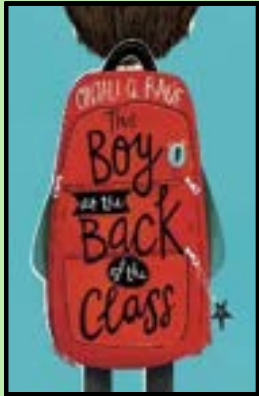
